Following this, you'll get in-depth insights how the Flying Bulls get airborne with a behind the scenes tour of Hangar-8 itself and the incredible aircraft that make up the Bulls' Fleet, all in the company of the pilots themselves.

Following your aerial tour, we'll finish a remarkable first day of Grand Tauro with a trip to the Red Bull Arena, home of FC Red Bull Salzburg, for an access-all-areas tour of the stadium, including areas normally reserved for players, team personnel and press.

DAY TWO »»» ON THE ROAD AND IN THE TUNNEL

DC rejoins us at the start of day 2 for a deep dive into the history of Red Bull through the eyes of one of its key athletes. The 13-time grand prix winner and Red Bull Racing's first podium finisher will take you through the history of the company and the foundation of its F1 teams.

Fully immersed in Red Bull culture, and fully fed with a superb lunch, we'll hit the road for the first leg of our journey to Silverstone. Ahead of us lies a drive through some of Europe's most stunning scenery as we put the pedal to the metal for Prague.

Our time in the historic capital of the Czech Republic won't just be about amazing architecture and medieval marvels, though. In the evening we'll bring you bang up to date at the Hurricane Factory, where you'll experience what it's like to be in a wind-tunnel, flying in a vertical wind tunnel in air flows up to 270km/h. It's a wind-in-the-hair experience no convertible can ever match!

Finally, we'll check in to the five-star Mandarin Oriental. Located in Prague's historic Malá Strana district, the luxury hotel is only a few steps from the iconic Charles Bridge and Prague Castle.

ON THE FAST TRACK TO THE 'GREEN HELL'

After a hearty breakfast, we hit the road once more and this time we're mixing the heart-stopping beauty with heart-pounding excitement as we travel through northern Bavaria and make our way to the mighty Nürburgring.

The first leg of the drive takes us to the amazing town of Rothenburg ob der Tauber. At a time when Berlin and Munich were muddy spots on the road, Rothenburg was bossing it as Germany's second-largest city with a population of 6,000. With more than a thousand years of history etched into its cobbled streets, this almost perfectly preserved walled town is one of Germany's must-sees.

It's also going to be our lunch location and with stunning views over the Tauber river, we're treating you to a gourmet picnic.

After lunch it's time to strap in for an adrenaline-pumping stint on Germany's limit-free autobahn as we make our way towards one of the world's most famous race circuits – the Nürburgring.

On arrival you'll get a first taste of the track's fearsome 154-corner layout alongside a pro-driver who'll take you on a no-holds barred lap of the 20km 'Green Hell'.

Your appetite for racing whetted, we'll try to sate it with dinner at one of the most famous motorsport restaurants in the world – Pistenklaus. A regular haunt for F1 drivers through the decades, it boasts incredible memorabilia to go along with its awesome stone-cooked steaks.

DRIVING EXPERIENCE

After flying through Flugplatz and careering around Karussell in an M5, today is all about your car and your skill at the wheel as we head to the Mendig Test Track. With a Red Bull athlete as your host you'll be able to put the ultimate power of your car to the test on the 1600m, 36m-wide runway and push the boundaries of its handling on the 2.1km circuit. It's not only the cars that will get a workout. We'll also be testing your limits and pitting you against your fellow Grand Tauros' in a series of timed challenges, speed tests and in our fastest lap competition.

Once the track action is complete we'll pause for a mouthwatering trackside BBQ and after rewarding the winning drivers with a bubbly-drenched podium ceremony we'll hit the road once more as we head for beautiful Bruges where we'll check into the five-star Hotel De Tuilerieen before discovering just why Bruges is known as the Venice of the North with a sunset canal cruise to dinner.

The Grand Tauro's ultimate target is in sight as we head to the UK on the Eurotunnel and take a final drive north to our HQ and then to the home of the British Grand Prix – Silverstone.

Our first stop is the Red Bull Technology campus in Milton Keynes, home of Oracle Red Bull Racing. We'll arrive at MK-7, where you'll not only be served brunch, you'll also be given a tour of the Team's incredible museum. MK-7 houses the full fleet of Red Bull Racing F1 cars from the RB5 that DC drove to a superb fourth place on our 2005 debut, right up to the double-title winning RB18, our most successful car ever.

From MK-7 we'll dive deep into the race weekend, first with pre-race briefing from one of our senior strategists and then we'll gain access to a space that's normally off-limits to all but the most qualified Team personnel – the Race Operations Room.

With a real-time data link to the Team in the garage and the car on track, the Ops Room is staffed by three teams of engineers advising on race strategy, aero performance, and vehicle dynamics. This is your opportunity to witness the inner workings of our F1 Team and get to know how the strategy and car set up is decided for each race weekend.

After watching how the Team tackles opening practice and how the Ops Room analyses the RB19's performance through the session, we'll hit the road once more. This time, though, we'll be led by a very special point man - Daniel Ricciardo.

The eight-time grand prix-winning Honey Badger will lead the Grand Tauro as we make our way to our final destination, Silverstone, where we'll arrive in time for FP2 and those crucial early quali sims.

To end our day, you will enjoy sunset in the Formula 1 Paddock with exclusive drinks and canapes on the infamous Red Bull Energy Station. The Team will take you on a guided tour of our garage where you will gain all of the behind-thescenes insight as our race team set up the cars for Qualifying tomorrow.
